ADOPTION OF THE SECOND DRAFT BY-LAW # 17-110 — AMENDING BY-LAW #08-38 **CONCERNING THE ZONING REGULATION**

WHEREAS the planning and urbanism Act provides that Council may change its regulations at any time (L. R. Q., chapter A - 19.1, articles 123 and following);

WHEREAS the Council wishes to allow commercial uses in the southern part of the development of Place des Marronniers;

WHEREAS the municipal Council wants to change the articles respectively on definitions, the size of the main buildings, the exterior siding, the canteens, isolated private garages, private greenhouses, canvas shelters, external combustion heating systems, winter shelters, retaining wall materials, materials of a fence, parking areas and firewood storage, existing livestock facilities, fines:

WHEREAS the municipal Council doesn't want to regulate anymore game equipment, protection of trees during work, height of the hedges, slope of the walkways of access, maintenance of the parking lots and reforestation of agricultural land;

WHEREAS a draft By-law has been adopted on April 3 2017;

WHEREAS a public consultation has been held on May 1, 2017;

RESOLUTION #17-05-84

<u>CREATION OF A REGIONAL COMMITTEE OF DISMANTLING OF THE BAIE-DES-SABLES'</u> <u>WIND FARM</u>

WHEREAS the Government of Quebec has issued, by Ministerial Decree in 2006 whose number is 129-2006, a certificate of approval for Cartier Énergie Éolienne (BDS) Inc. for the wind farm project of Baie-des-Sables on the territory of the municipality of Baie-des-Sables and the Town of Métis-sur-Mer;

WHEREAS in the condition #12 of the Decree, it is described that Cartier Énergie Éolienne (BDS) Inc must proceed to the complete dismantling of the wind farm within a period of two years following the final exploitation of the site, that the cost projected by this dismantling will have to be fully paid by the company and the company must provide adequate funding, by deposit in trust or by providing secure guarantees to obtain required amount;

WHEREAS the verification of the accumulated amount or secure guarantees should be done by a regional Committee that will be in place in the eleventh year of the agreement for a period of ten years;

WHEREAS Cartier Énergie Éolienne (BDS) Inc wishes that the two municipal entities are present on the Committee either by mayors and Directors General;

FOR THESE REASONS,

It is proposed by Councillor Mr. Simon Brochu and resolved unanimously that the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer names the Mayor and the director general to sit on the regional Committee of dismantling and to represent the Town of Métis-sur-Mer.

TO MANDATE A CONTRACTOR TO REDO THE ROOF OF THE FIRE STATION

WHEREAS this distribution is made in relation with the number of kilometers of local roads, over 45 km for the Town of Métis-sur-Mer;

WHEREAS deputies, in collaboration with the municipalities and the MRC, set up an annual programming of improvements by focusing on the local road network;

WHEREAS some gravel roads of Métis-sur-Mer require, as well as the regular maintenance, a recovering of gravel;

It is proposed by Councillor Ms. Martine Bouchard and resolved unanimously that the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer requests financial support from Mr. Pascal Bérubé, Deputy of Matapédia-Matane, of an amount of \$ 15 000.00, in relation to the program " Aide à l'amélioration du réseau routier 2016", in order to proceed to recover and to grade some parts of the following ranges: From route Plourde (north route132) until 2nd range and from the beginning of 2nd range East until intersection of rue de L'église.
