## ADOPTION OF SECOND DRAFT REGULATION 19-135 AMENDMENT TO THE REG. 08-38 ZONING BY-LAW

**WHEREAS** the act respecting land use planning and development provides that the Town Council may amend its urbanism planning (L. R. Q., chapter A-19.1, section 109 and the following);

**WHEREAS** the Town Council wishes to authorize two-family habitations in area where villégiature is allocated;

WHEREAS the Town Council wishes to adjust the storage standards in heavy industry areas;

**WHEREAS** the Town Council wishes to loosen rules for the installation of residential accessory buildings;

WHEREAS the Town Council wishes to provide some clarification to the zoning by-law;

WHEREAS a draft regulation has been adopted on May 6, 2019;

WHEREAS a notice of motion has been given at the meeting of May 6, 2019;

WHEREAS a public consultation meeting was held on June 3, 2019.

## FOR THESE REASONS

it is proposed by Councillor Mr. Raynald Banville and unanimously resolved that the first draft regulation number 19-135 be adopted as submitted to the members of the Council.

**WHEREAS** according to section 3.4 of the permit and certificate regulations, authorization of the Council by resolution is required to give the subdivision permit for a cadastral operation with five or more lots;

WHEREAS this application is intended to create lots 311-13 to 311-17;

WHEREAS this application is in accordance with the urban plan of Métis-sur-Mer;

**WHEREAS** there is no impact on water and sewer systems as well as on the possible supply of other municipal services in the sector concerned.

Turriff and unanimously resolved that the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer authorizes this subdivision application for a cadastral operation with five or more lots according to the subdivision plan made by Mr. Nelson Banville, surveyor, minute #4324, dated May 8, 2019.

**CONSIDERING THAT** the Town has received an offer of professional engineering services from the MRC de la Mitis concerning the local road assistance program section – RIRL road repairs;
