RESOLUTION 19-08-109 ACCOUNTS PAYABLE

It is proposed by Councillor Mr. Luc Hamelin and resolved unanimously that the Council of the Town of Metis-sur-Mer adopts the list of disbursements for an amount of \$ 119 272.24 for July 2019, adopts the list of accounts payable for an amount of \$ 63 925.75 for July 2019 and authorizes the Secretary - Treasurer to make the payment for these accounts. 6.1 Adoption of employee remuneration policy.

RESOLUTION #19-08-110

ADOPTION OF EMPLOYEE REMUNERATION POLICY

CONSIDERING THAT the Town's objectives in developing a remuneration policy are:

- To encourage staff to adopt attitudes and behaviours that contribute to the Town's goals and development strategy;
- To provide fair compensation to jobs in relation to the external market;
- To provide competitive salary conditions that respect the Town's capacity to pay;
- To manage remuneration efficiently, easily and flexibly.

CONSIDERING THAT a salary structure is also an effective tool to simplify management including:

- To allow for the accurate planning of the annual compensation budget;
- To provide a very specific framework for the city at the time of the annual salary review. Decisions will no longer be arbitrary;
- To eliminate all employee stake requests for wage reviews on an ad hoc basis.

FOR THESE REASONS,

It is proposed by Councillor Mr. Luc Hamelin and unanimously resolved that the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer adopts an employee remuneration policy proposed by the FQM for a period of 5 years from January 1, 2020 and which the Council will have to approve the increasing of the wage scale.

<u>APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT IN PIIA ZONE AT 374 RUE BEACH</u>

The application for a building permit is for the expansion of a main building in the PIIA area.

CONSIDERING THAT the location of the site retains its natural features (relief, vegetation, drainage...) and the enlarged building does not obstruct visual breakthroughs on elements of heritage or landscape interest from the public road;

CONSIDERING THAT the shape, slope and materials of the roofs of the enlarged part are like those of the original part;

CONSIDERING THAT the type of material used for the exterior cladding of the walls of the enlarged part are similar in appearance or complement visually the original part.

It is proposed by Councillor Mr. Luc Hamelin and unanimously resolved that the council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer accepts the recommendations of the CCU and allows the application as submitted in all documents submitted for approval of a permit application in the PIIA area.
