- the municipality of Métis-sur-Mer agrees to be solely responsible and to relieve Canada and Quebec as well as their Ministers, senior officials, employees and agents of any liability for claims, demands, losses, damages or costs of all kinds related to injuries inflicted on a person, the death of a person, damage to property or loss of property caused by a deliberate or negligent act, coming directly or indirectly from the investments made with the financial help obtained with the financial assistance program of the 2019-2023 TECQ;

NOTICE OF MOTION FOR REGULATION 19-139 AUTHORIZING A SUPERVISOR TO DRIVE IN A ROAD VEHICLE DURING A SNOW REMOVAL OPERATION ON A PUBLIC ROAD WITH A SNOWBLOWER

Councillor Mr. Simon Brochu gave notice of motion that a regulation governing snow removal operations on a public road with a snowblower will be submitted for adoption at a next meeting. The purpose of this regulation is to allow the use of escorted vehicles during snow removal on a public road with a snowblower on certain roads of the municipality. This draft regulation will be presented for adoption at a future session.

RESOLUTION #19-11-153 WINTER MAINTENANCE OF THE 5TH RANGE OF PADOUE

It is proposed by Councillor Ms. Martine Bouchard and resolved unanimously that the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer accepts to take in charge winter upkeep of 5th range of Padoue for the season 2018-2020, on a length of 1.91 km for the sum of \$ 9 400.00, conditional on the following terms of payment:

9. FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICE

9.1 Financial assistance program for the training of volunteer firefighters.

<u>RESOLUTION #19-11-154</u> FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR THE TRAINING OF VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS

WHEREAS the *Règlement sur les conditions pour exercer au sein d'un service de sécurité incendie municipal* provides the training requirements for firefighters in fire safety in order to ensure a minimum qualification.

WHEREAS this regulation reflects a determination of municipalities to guarantee the formation of a team of firefighters with qualifications and skills to respond effectively in an emergency situation;

WHEREAS in December 2014, the Government of Quebec established the Program of financial assistance for the training of volunteer or part-time firefighters;

WHEREAS this program aims to provide financial assistance to municipal organizations allowing them to have a sufficient number of firefighters qualified to take part effectively and safely in an emergency situation;

WHEREAS this program also aims to promote the acquisition of abilities and basic skills required by volunteer or part-time firefighters who operate within municipal fire safety services;

WHEREAS the Town of Métis-sur-Mer wishes to benefit from the financial assistance offered by this program;

WHEREAS the Town of Métis-sur-Mer provides the formation of two firefighters in the coming year to respond effectively and in a safe manner to emergency situations on its territory;

WHEREAS the municipality must send its request to the *Ministère de la sécurité public* through the MRC de La Mitis in accordance with article 6 of the Program.

It is proposed by Councillor Mr. René Lepage and resolved unanimously that the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer submits an application for financial assistance under the program of financial assistance for the formation of volunteer or part-time firefighters at the Department of public safety and to transmit this request to the MRC de La Mitis.

10.1 Maintenance of the 2019-2020 ice rink.

RESOLUTION #19-11-155 MAINTENANCE OF THE 2019-2020 ICE RINK

It is proposed by Councillor Mr. Luc Hamelin and resolved unanimously that the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer donates \$6 140.00 to the Leisure Committee of Métis-sur-Mer for the maintenance of the municipal skating rink during winter 2019-2020 as well as for clearing snow from the main and secondary entrances at the municipal office and at the recreation center.

RESOLUTION #19-11-156 PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT AT THE LEISURE CENTRE AND BUDGET TRANSFER
