RESOLUTION #20-01-10 OPINION IN FAVOR OF THE SECOND PRELIMINARY DIRECTION FOR THE COLLECTIVE APPLICATION

WHEREAS under ARTICLE 59 of the *Loi sur la protection du territoire et des activités agricoles*, the MRC de la Mitis submitted on April 13, 2016, an application to the Commission de protection du territoire agricole du Québec (CPTAQ) for the purpose of determining in which circumstances and under what conditions new uses for residential purposes could be established in the agricultural area;

WHEREAS under article 12 of the *Loi sur la protection du territoire et des activités agricoles*, the CPTAQ must consider the context of regional peculiarities in the exercise of its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS negotiating meetings were held on October 17 and 18, 2016;

WHEREAS the CPTAQ issued a preliminary decision on April 7, 2018 to the case 412212;

WHEREAS this draft agreement was not the subject of consensus between the parties;

WHEREAS an additional negotiation meeting was held on December 10, 2019;

WHEREAS the CPTAQ issued a second preliminary direction on December 20, 2019;

WHEREAS under section 62.6 of the *Loi sur la protection du territoire et des activités agricoles*, the municipality must give a favorable opinion with respect to this preliminary direction for a decision to be rendered.

FOR THESE REASONS:

It is proposed by Councillor Ms. Rita D. Turriff and unanimously resolved to give a favorable opinion to the second preliminary direction issued by the CPTAQ on December 20, 2019 concerning the collective application, (case 412212).
