WHEREAS the Ministère des Transports, (MTQ) has paid compensation of \$ 134 428 for the maintenance of local roads for 2020;

WHEREAS as a result of the changes made by the ministère des Affaires municipales et de l'Habitation (MAMH), the municipality must attest and confirm the use of this amount and the total amount of expenses of \$ 284 976, registered on page 51-4 of the financial report;

WHEREAS compensation distributed to the municipality aims to accomplish the preventive work and the general maintenance of local routes 1 and 2 as well as bridges, located on these roads, which are the responsibility of the municipality;

FOR THESE REASONS,

It is proposed by Councillor Mr. Christopher Astle and resolved unanimously that the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer informs the *Ministère des Transports* of the use of the grant for the preventive work and the general maintenance of local routes 1 and 2 as well as bridges, located on these roads, which are the responsibility of the municipality, in accordance with the objectives of the *Programme d'aide à l'entretien du réseau routier local*.

CONSIDERING THAT following the deposit of the land reform, a vacant lot number 6,205,848, 2,863 m2 is now owned by the Town of Métis-sur-Mer;

CONSIDERING THAT this land causes harm to the current owners for the sale of their building;

FOR THESE REASONS,

It is proposed by Councillor Ms. Rita D. Turriff and unanimously resolved that the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer sells for \$1 this land number 6,205,848 lot to the estate of Ms. Simone Lebel and the estate agreed to pay all costs related to this sale. The council also appoints the Director General to sign the sales documents on behalf of the Town.
