5. OPEN VARIA.

5.1 Adoption of By-law #18-122, managing the question period.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer must, in accordance with article 322 of the Cities and Towns Act, hold a question period at a Council meeting;

WHEREAS the Council considers that the question period is available to ask questions of public interest relating to the municipal administration to ensure a compliant and respectful behavior;

WHEREAS a notice of motion accompanied by a draft regulation has been previously given by Councillor Ms. Martine Bouchard at the meeting of the Council held on March 12th, 2018. **WHEREAS** a copy of this regulation was available no later than two (2) days before the present meeting to the person responsible to the access to documents of the Town;

WHEREAS a copy of this regulation was available to the public at the beginning of this meeting;

ACCORDINGLY, a resolution has been passed by the Town to adopt this regulation as deposited and submitted to the Town Council.

5.2 Adoption of By-law #18-123, about contract management.

WHEREAS a contractual management policy has been adopted by the Town of Métis-sur-Mer in accordance with article 573.3.1.2 of the Cities and Towns Act (hereinafter referred to as "C.T.A.");

WHEREAS article 573.3.1.2 *C.T.A.* was replaced on January 1, 2018, obliging the municipalities, from that last date, to adopt a regulation on contract management, the current policy of the municipality being however deemed to be such a regulation;

WHEREAS the regulations must at least provide measures in respect of six items identified in the Act and, in respect of contracts that have an expenditure of 25 000 \$ or more but less than 100 000 \$ and which may be passed over-the-counter under the rules adopted by the municipality, provide for measures to ensure the rotation of any other contractor;

WHEREAS the municipality wishes, as permitted by the fourth paragraph of article 573.3.1.2 *C.T.A.*, to provide for the award of contracts which include an expenditure of more than 25 000 \$ and less than 100 000 \$ and, as a result, article 573.1 *L.C.V.* no longer applies to these contracts from the entry into force of this regulation;

WHEREAS this draft By-law responds to a goal of transparency and clean management of public funds:

WHEREAS the Director general and Secretary-Treasurer mentions that the purpose of this regulation is to provide measures for any contract to be given by the municipality, including certain rules for the award of contracts for agreements that have an expenditure of at least 25 000 \$ and less than 100 000 \$;

WHEREAS a notice of motion accompanied by a proposed regulation has been previously given by Councillor Mr. Luc Hamelin at the meeting of the Council held on March 12, 2018;

WHEREAS a copy of this regulation was available no later than two (2) days before the present meeting to the person responsible to the access to documents of the Town;

WHEREAS a copy of this regulation was available to the public at the beginning of this meeting

ACCORDINGLY, a resolution has been passed by the Town to adopt this regulation as deposited and submitted to the Town Council.

5.3 Adoption of By-law #18-124, amending By-law #12-73, access to home ownership program.

WHEREAS the Director General mentions that the purpose of this regulation is to amend Regulation number 12-73 to amend various elements of the access to home ownership program;

WHEREAS a notice of motion accompanied by a proposed regulation has been previously given by Councillor Mr. Simon Brochu at the meeting of the Council held on March 12, 2018;

WHEREAS a copy of this regulation was available no later than two (2) days before the present meeting to the person responsible to the access to documents of the Town;

WHEREAS a copy of this regulation was available to the public at the beginning of this meeting

ACCORDINGLY, a resolution has been passed by the Town to adopt this regulation as deposited and submitted to the Town Council.

5.4 Request to Mr. Pascal Bérubé for graveling of MacNider Road – South 4th range and upkeeping bridge P-04432 – Chemin Des Ecossais.

WHEREAS the budget of the program « Aide à l'amélioration du réseau routier » is distributed among provincial electoral districts;

WHEREAS this distribution is made in relation with the number of kilometers of local roads, over 45 km for the Town of Métis-sur-Mer;

WHEREAS deputies, in collaboration with the municipalities and the MRC, set up an annual programming of improvements by focusing on the local road network;

WHEREAS some gravel roads of Métis-sur-Mer require, as well as the regular maintenance, a recovering of gravel;

WHEREAS the Town has received a letter dated February 26 2018 from the MTMDET to do work on the P-04432 bridge located on the chemin des Écossais;

FOR THESE REASONS.

A resolution has been adopted by the Town to request financial support from Mr. Pascal Bérubé, Deputy of Matapédia-Matane, of an amount of \$ 15 000.00, in relation to the program " Aide à l'amélioration du réseau routier 2016", in order to proceed to recover and to grade some parts of the following ranges: route MacNider (south 4th range) and to do the repairs required by the MTMDET on the P-04432 bridge.

5.5 To award contract for the upkeep of the retaining wall.

WHEREAS the Town proceeded with the opening of the tenders for the repair of the retaining wall:

WHEREAS ten (10) contractors have deposited a tender;

WHEREAS the engineering department of the MRC de la Mitis did the analysis of tenders;

WHEREAS the engineering department of the MRC de la Mitis recommends the award of the contract to "MVC Océan Inc.", which is the lowest compliant tenderer in an amount of 168,804.00 taxes included:

WHEREAS the supervision of the work will be carried out by the engineering department of the MRC de la Mitis.

THEREFORE, a resolution has been adopted by the Town to award the contract to "MVC Océan Inc." for the repair of the retaining wall in an amount of 168,804.00 taxes included. This work is included in the programming of the work of the TECQ 2014-2018.

5.6 Cartier 2018 Fund – Requests from Organizations.

CONSIDERING THAT, according to the agreement signed by Cartier Energy with the Town of Métis-sur-Mer about the "Visibility Funds", the municipality must submit its recommendations on projects for the social and community development for an amount of \$5,187.22 by resolution for 2018.

A resolution has been adopted by the Town to recommend that Cartier Énergie Éolienne pays the following amounts to non-profit municipal organizations:
