CONSIDERING THAT the Town of Métis-sur-Mer in June 2020, by Resolution 20-06-90, awarded a brokerage contract to Ms. Geneviève Côté for the sale of the Place des Marronniers land for \$124,900;

CONSIDERING THAT contractor Mr. Martin Michaud signed a promise to purchase the land for \$125,000;

CONSIDERING THAT the buyer aims to develop a residential area.
